Rates, Terms and Policies: Our hourly/man rate for the upcoming 2021 season will be \$41.00. Your Lawn Cutting rate for 2021 is listed on your lawn confirmation. We would like to take this time to clarify our billing policies with all of our customers. Lawn maintenance balances are due within 7 days of billing. Landscaping projects are billed upon completion and balances are due within 7 days of billing. **Any overdue balances of 30 days will result in a 1.5% interest charge.** Services will be reinstated once balances are brought to date. With the rapid rise in fuel prices we will reserve the right to add a temporary fuel surcharge should gas rise above \$3.00/gallon mark. Again we hope we will not have to implement this charge. There will be **NO increase in lawn cutting rates for 2021.**
